Would you like to read, study, or learn Czech with us? We offer:



- Czech language textbooks: Our collection includes high-quality textbooks for beginners and advanced learners.
- Books in many languages: Read in English, Ukrainian, Russian, German, French, Spanish, or Italian.
- Czech language courses: We offer regular Czech lessons (more information at: www.kurzycj.cz/en/).
- Help from librarians: Don't hesitate to ask! We will help you navigate the library, our online catalogue, and reader services.

How to register

You do not need a library card to visit the library – entry is free for everyone.

If you would like to borrow books, please bring a valid ID, and we will create a reader account for you. The fee is paid once a year upon registration:

- Adults (15 let a více): 150 CZK / year
- Children (Ages 7–14): 50 CZK / year
- Children under 7: free
- Seniors (70+): free
- Ukrainian citizens: free

(Children under 15 must be registered by a parent or legal guardian.)

More than just books (Additional services)

- Consultations with CPIC: Do you need advice on dealing with authorities or residence permits? You can regularly meet staff from the Centre for the Support of Integration of Foreigners (CPIC) directly at the library.
- Wi-Fi and PCs: Free internet access and use of public computers.
- For families: The children's department offers a play area, reading corner, and relaxation space for parents with young children. Older children can take advantage of the TEEN CLUB.
- Cultural and educational events: The library organizes lectures, talks, author readings, and other engaging events for the public.
